

ELEVENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT JUVENILE DRUG COURT

CONTRACT FOR ADMISSION

I, _____ commit myself to working within the Outpatient Alcohol and/or Drug Treatment Program offered by the Juvenile Drug Court. This commitment to complete the Drug Court Program is a requirement of my probation and/or Condition of Release. I will continue to meet the terms of my Juvenile Probation Agreement.

I understand that this is a four (4) phase program with a continuing care component lasting a minimum of 8 months (240 days). I understand that I may be required to repeat all or a portion of a program phase if I have not completed with the requirements outlined in this contract or if I have not complied as directed by the judge. I understand this commitment means that I will:

- Participate in the Grade Court Program to the extent deemed necessary and abide by the program rules and sanctions.
- Submit to screening, assessment, and random laboratory testing for the presence of alcohol, drugs and/or other mind-altering chemicals. “Stalls, Diluting” or tampering with any drug test sample will result in sanctions from the court. U.A. collections will be subject to observation by approved male and female Drug Court Staff.
- Attend alcohol education meeting, individual counseling sessions, group therapy, family counseling sessions, and 12-Step support groups.
- Encourage my family (or significant other) to attend the educational meetings, multifamily sessions and process groups, family therapy sessions, and Life Skills Training.
- Practice TOTAL ABSTINENCE from alcohol or mind-altering chemicals for the period of this treatment.

I understand that the commitment I am making also means that:

- My attendance at all scheduled sessions or appointments is mandatory and takes precedence over all non-critical medical concerns and/or commitments. In the event that a medical or family emergency arises I will provide the Drug Court staff with documentation of said emergency.
- I will arrive on time for all scheduled sessions and/or appointments including AA and NA meetings.
- A physical examination, by a physician of my choice, may be required prior to admission to determine the appropriateness of treatment in the Juvenile Drug Court Program. I understand that payment for such an examination is my responsibility.
- Possession of a firearm during any treatment activity is strictly prohibited and could result in a violation of probation and possible detention.

- A negative attitude, intentional failure to cooperate, aggressive and/or violent acts are possible grounds for discharge from treatment and could result in a violation of probation or conditions of release, and possible detention.
- I will not under any circumstances drive while under the influence of alcohol, drugs and/or other mind-altering chemicals. I understand this act may be possible grounds for discharge from treatment and could result in a violation of probation or conditions of release, and possible detention.
- I understand that consuming Poppy Seeds will result in a “positive” drug screen. I will not consume any food item that contains Poppy Seeds while on the Juvenile Drug Court Program.
- Allow for home visits and searches of my person, living quarters, vehicle, etc.

Failures to fulfill the terms of this contract are possible grounds for discharge from the Juvenile Drug Court Program.

If I do not comply with the terms of this contract, I understand that a petition will be filed to revoke my probation or my conditions of release may be terminated and I may be detained.

I understand that the release of information, which I have signed, is an integral part of my treatment program, which allows the Juvenile Drug Court and other specified individuals and agencies to monitor and review my progress. In the event I revoke my consent to release information or fail to renew such consent, if requested, while I am still in treatment, I specifically authorize the Juvenile Drug Court to be advised of my refusal to renew or my revocation of the consent to release information, which will result in the termination of my participation in the program.

I understand I must comply with all the terms of my Probation Agreement or Conditions of Release and failure to do so could result in a violation of probation or conditions of release and possible detention.

I have received and reviewed a copy of the program orientation for the Juvenile Drug Court Program.
